# The PARTNER 2 Study

## What is the PARTNER Study?

The PARTNER 2 study is a study looking at the risks of HIV transmission when someone is taking effective HIV treatment.

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## Who can take part?

**You and your partner are eligible to take part in the study if:**

- One of you is an HIV positive man and on treatment and the other is HIV negative man
- You have had condomless anal sex together in the past month
- You expect to have sex together again in the coming months



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Everyone in the study is advised to use a condom each time they have sex
