

The HIV population in two sites in the PARTNER

Characteristics relative to the PARTNER study:

1550/430 patients have been approached:

48%/35% - had no regular partnership

15%/11% - had a sero-positive partner

20%/19% - systematically used a condom with their partner

7%/? - had a stable partnership but no sexual life with their partner

6%/14% - had other reasons not to participate (refusal from patient or partner, unknown HIV status of the partner, etc.)

Feedback on recruitment and follow-up rates Recruitment More difficult than expected to reach the enrolment goals Only about 20% of the HIV positive patients have been asked about PARTNER Refocus on PARTNER in the clinic and contact couples that initially showed some interest Focus on MSM couples as a new approach
