This is the third biweekly update on the formation of the PERSIMUNE Centre of Excellence (CoE).

- 1. The signing of the three party contract (DNRF, RH and me) seems reasonable to expect to occur next week or the week thereafter. There is a subsequent important process in preparation to ensure that leadership within the hospital and fully briefed on the vision and operational activities of the CoE.
- 2. The directors of the hospital has agreed to rent 500 m2 space for the headquarter of the CoE negotiations with the renter is ongoing will announce location once signature of lease is placed. There will be meeting facilities, and space for researchers to work.
