Dear EuroSIDA Study Investigators,

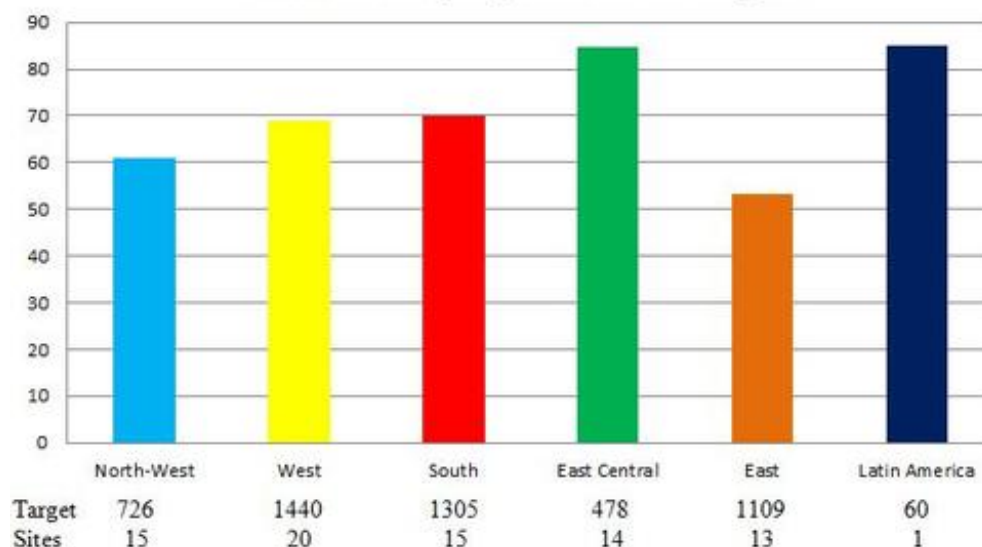
The staff at the EuroSIDA coordinating centre wishes you a great summer and kindly thank you for your excellent work and continued contribution to the EuroSIDA study. Below, please find an update on the EuroSIDA study.

Enrolment status for the new EuroSIDA cohort

Enrolment in cohort 10 approaches 3,500 patients and the EuroSIDA team remains hopeful that we will reach our study objective of 5,000 co-infected patients in the new cohort. Enrolment will continue through 2015 and we strongly urge those participating centres who have not yet reached their stipulated target to **please continue to enroll patients in REDCap as fast as possible**.

So far 3,400 patients, **66% of the currently target of 5,000, have been enrolled**. 78 centres from 31 countries are so far contributing to the cohort and 36 centres have reached their enrolment target. The EuroSIDA team would like to thank these sites for their professional work done to complete the enrolment process.

REDCap reminders

When you complete **HCV Treatment forms** in REDCap, please remember to follow the criteria for completion which are now written at the top of the forms in REDCap. Please also remember not to complete the form in the 'Form status' section at the bottom, before stop date for treatment has been filled in as well as all other required values in the data fields. HCV Treatment forms which do not meet the criteria will be deleted from REDCap.

Dataset 42

The deadline for completing dataset 42 is **14 August 2015**. We urge all centres to please complete all follow-up forms as soon as possible.

EuroSIDA and D:A:D

Please note that patients enrolled in EuroSIDA cohort 10 are not included in D:A:D, and **D:A:D event forms should therefore not be completed for cohort 10 patients**. For patients enrolled in earlier EuroSIDA cohorts there are no changes with regards to D:A:D.

If a patient has **died**, information regarding death should now be completed in **Section B** in the follow-up form.

Please remember to **always complete all sections in REDCap for both enrolment and follow-up forms**. When all new data have been reported in the follow-up form, please remember to **choose 'complete' in the status section**. If there is no new information or no corrections to a patient form, either because the patient is dead or because the patient is LTFU, you can report this information in section B and go to the 'status section' and choose 'complete'. However, please first review the data collected so far on this patient and make corrections if needed. If you correct data, please change the status of the sections to complete.
