PARTNER study: improvement in knowledge of HIV transmission rate for MSM

PARTNER 2 study – Original Plan

At the end of PARTNER 1 (31st May 2014): 340 MSM couples contributed to 439 eligible CYFU.

IF:

- we recruit 450 MSM couples (uniformly over 27 months from 1st June 2014 to 31st August 2016 [planned end of recruitment])
- Couples are followed until 31st March 2017 [planned end of follow-up]
- there is a retention rate of 85% per year
- 85% of all CYFU are eligible

THEN


 1,770 eligible CYFU would be accumulated by the end of PARTNER 2 (planned end of follow-up 31st March2017)





PARTNER 2 study – Original Recruitment Plan

Original design: 450 MSM couples/27 months = $^{\sim}17$ couples/month





PARTNER 2 study – Revised Plan

1,770 eligible CYFU by the end of PARTNER 2

IF

- we recruit 14 MSM couples (uniformly from February 2016 to 30st June 2017)
- couples are followed until 31st December 2017 (then moved to March 2018)
- there is a retention rate of 80% per year
- 79% of all CYFU are eligible






PARTNER 2 study – Revised Recruitment Plan

Original design: 450 MSM couples/27 months = ~17 couples/month


Revised design: 14 couples/month (Feb2016 - end Jun2017) (Total MSM couples= 546)




PARTNER 2 study – Revised recruitment plan

Original design: 450 MSM couples/27 months = ~17 couples/month


Revised design: 14 couples/month (Feb2016 - end Jun2017) (Total MSM couples=546)

Actual: 13.8 couples/month (Feb2016 - end Jun2017)






PARTNER 2 study – CYFU accumulated








PARTNER 2 study – potential CYFU





Strategies for increasing eligible CYFU



Dear participant,

We send you this postcard as a thank you to you and your partner for helping with the PARTNER 2 study.

We also want to remind you of the importance of the final clinic visit, which needs to be before 31st March 2018.

The PARTNER 2 study will finish collecting data at that time, therefore it is very important that you attend your final clinic visit as close as possible to the 31* March deadline. The closer you are to that date, the more you will contribute to the results.

The PARTNER and PARTNER 2 studies are the largest studies to include gay men in a study of HIV transmission. They are also the largest studies that are able to quantify the impact of HIV treatment in reducing the risk of HIV transmission. The results have helped to change guidelines about HIV risk and also helped reduce stigma and discrimination.

Your help with this final visit is just as important as your help throughout the duration of the project.

The final visit will make the results stronger and more powerful.

Closure of PARTNER at sites

1. Close enrolment 30th June 2017

2. Continuing follow up the 31st March 2018

- Allowing couples to follow their regular visit schedule at the clinic.
- Ask couples to come in for their final visit in December 2017 – which can be done up to 31st March 2018.



Final visit in PARTNER

- Final visit data required:
 - HIV test (negative partner) and VL (positive partner)
 - A questionnaire from both (but especially the negative partner)
