The new EuroSIDA cohort

Seventy-two EuroSIDA centres have expressed interest in including HIV/HCV co-infected patients into the new EuroSIDA Cohort 10. In addition, we are happy to welcome two new EuroSIDA sites, Poznan in Poland and Tbilisi in Georgia.

Ethical approval has so far been obtained by 36 centres, which are hereby ready to enrol patients. Enrolment of the targeted number of patients should be completed within three months. **Patients who are already in EuroSIDA cannot be enrolled into the new cohort.**

It's our experience that many centres fill out the case-report forms in batches, but for the coordinating centre at CHIP to be able to monitor the progress of enrolment, **we encourage you to complete at least section A** (demography and HIV status) of the enrolment forms shortly after the informed consent has been obtained.
