• How we recruit participants?





- We work hand to hand with BCN Checkpoint, a CBO for the detection of HIV and other STI in MSM
- It is based in Barcelona
- It is the most active Community
 Organization working with MSM in Spain
 (>4000 people tested in 2013)
- They inform about the PARTNER study to potential participants, stressing the importance of having data about the risk of HIV transmission among MSM
- Participants are visited there









At Hospital level: key points

- To ask patients whether they have a partner
- In case they have, to inform them about the PARTNER study:

"We know there are couples who have decided not using condom, or at least not using it always..."

- To ask them about condom use with their partners
- To offer participating in the study, stressing the importance of having more data on risk of HIV transmission among gay couples





Obstacles

- Average duration of gay couples
- Fear of being judged by health professionals
- Concerns about risk of transmission
- "Conservative" opinion among health providers
